## Prize Money

**The top three finishers in the elite categories of the RheinMainCityRace 2019 / City Race Euro Tour will receive prize money of €150 / €100 / €50**

The top three finishers in the other categories as well as all categories on Saturday (Deutsche Park Tour / Rhein-Main-Rang-Liste) will receive prizes and certificates.

In the children and youth classes (M/W-10, M/W-12, M/W-14) places 4 to 6 also receive prizes and certificates.

## Competition Centre / Event Office

The event office is located for the entire weekend on the grounds of the **Darmstädter TSG 1846 (Heinrich-Fuhr-Straße 40, 64287 Darmstadt)**.

The competition centres for the individual races are located directly at the respective arenas (see individual days).

## Catering

Catering is available on all three days. The Darmstadt TSG 1846 provides chilled drinks as well as grilled dishes and fries. In addition there are vegetarian wheat patties, coffee and cake.

Refreshments are available in the finish area.

## Transport

### Car / Bus

Take the A5 or A67 towards the Darmstadt interchange, then take the A672 towards the city centre. Official parking spaces are available only to a limited extent at the event office at the Darmstadt TSG 1846 grounds (Heinrich-Fuhr-Straße 40, 64287 Darmstadt).

The individual competition centers are easily accessible by public transport (see individual days or 'latest information').

**Please leave the car behind on the weekend !**

### Plane / Train / Public Transport

International participants can easily reach Darmstadt via Frankfurt airport. From there an express bus (AIRliner) drives directly to Darmstadt. From the airports of Luxembourg and Frankfurt / Hahn, a flibco long-distance bus service operates as an airport shuttle directly to Frankfurt Airport and Frankfurt Main Station.

Train passengers travel to Darmstadt central station (InterCity / ICE network, regional and S-Bahn). From Darmstadt Central Station, several bus and tram lines run into the city centre. ## Showers / WC

## General Information

### Punching

SportIdent with Air + enabled. Traditional SI also possible. SI card rental (no SIAC) is possible on a limited basis for **3,- EUR/day**.

### Prestart

On Friday and Saturday the prestart is at -3 minutes.

**On Sunday, the pre-start will be extended to -6 minutes (please note!).**

### Shoes

**Spikes in any form are not allowed.** In addition to the urban, sealed surfaces, the choice of suitable running shoes should also take into account that courses may encounter park and smaller forest areas as well as small slopes.

### Construction Sites

The races take place in urban terrain. It is therefore possible that construction sites are present that did not exist when the map was made. This also applies in the park and gardens.

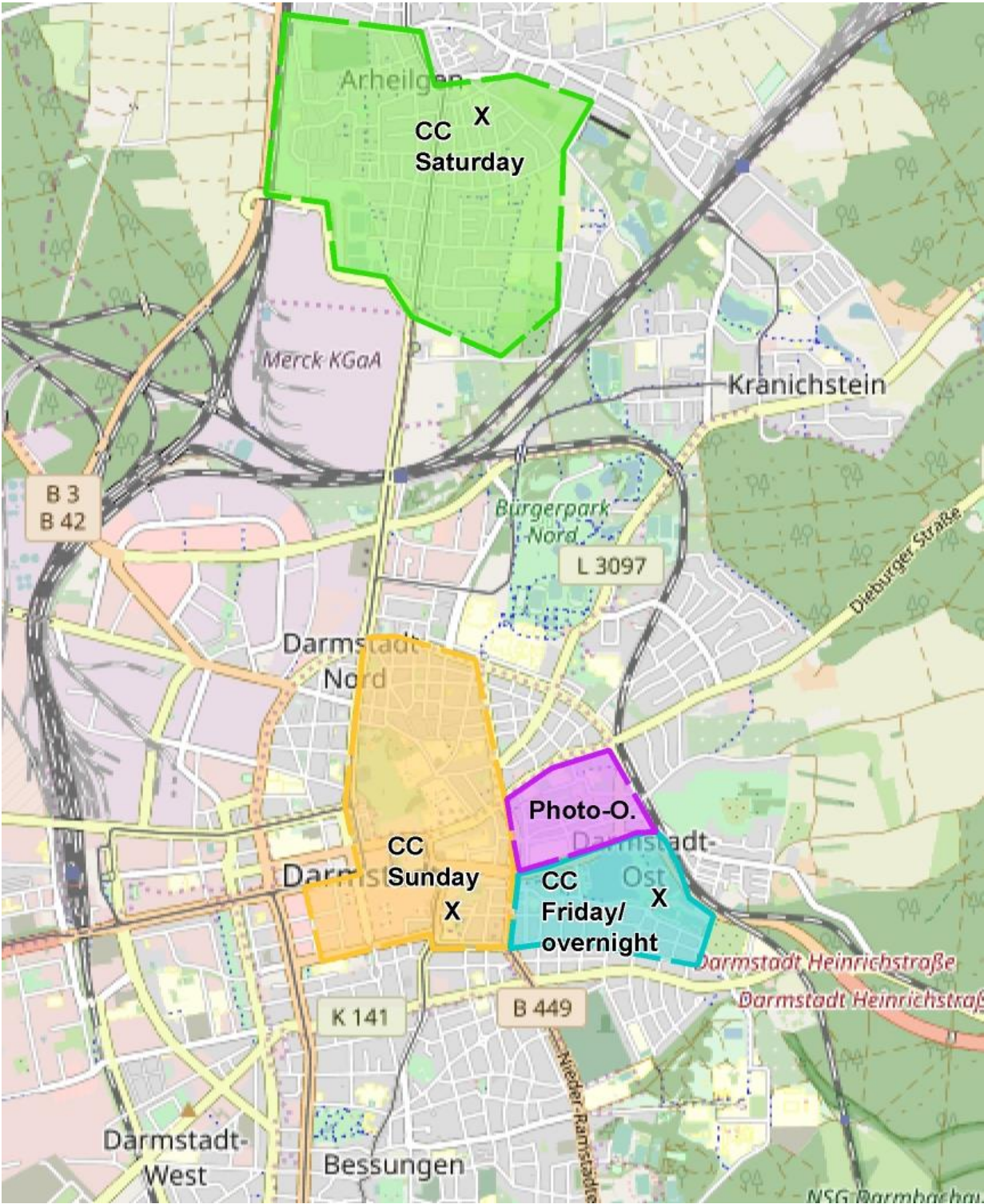
### First aid / Paramedics

# Day 1 – Sprint-Prologue

Friday, August 23, 2019

To kick off the weekend, a sprint prologue will take place on Friday evening at the university campus "**Lichtwiese**" and the neighbouring **Woog quarter**.

The area offers park-like sections with meadows and woodland as well as urban areas with winding running tracks.

The runability is good with isolated slopes.

There is no fixed start list. Between 6:00 pm and 9:00 pm you can put your name on the start list at the event centre and go to the start accordingly

## Day 2 – Deutsche Park Tour / Rhein-Main-Rang-Liste

Saturday, August 24, 2019

The venue for day 2 is the **district Arheilgen**, a small suburb to the north of Darmstadt. The terrain of detached and terraced houses, small open spaces in between and larger complexes of buildings offers tricky route choices and at the top speed requires good planning and quick decisions. Coastal feeling comes in the western part of the map, where a dune-like noise protection dam with various playgrounds brings some altitude in the otherwise flat terrain.

## Day 3 – City Race Euro Tour / RheinMainCityRace 2019

Sunday, August 25, 2019

The race with **City Race Euro Tour** points and the centrepiece event also marks the conclusion of the weekend: the **RheinMainCityRace 2019**.

With the Darmstadt city centre, the Martins Quarter and the Herrngarten, an orienteering and touristic highlight awaits the participants. In the heart of Darmstadt, the most diverse types of terrain meet: the northern part of the map is located in the Martins Quarter, which dates back to the Wilhelminian era. Here, in addition to classic route choices, it is important to find the right access to winding courtyards. To the south the courses navigate the Herrngarten, an English park from the 18th century, the Hessian State Museum and the 120-year-old campus of the Technical University.

The changes of terrain demand the attention of the runners, because the parks allow high speed over open meadows, while the campus with stairs and different levels rewards more precise fine orientation. After a map change, competitors pass Darmstadt castle and Luisenplatz in the sprawling pedestrian zone. Here, numerous alleyways and passages provide adequate complexity.

## Extra events

### Kids course / Photo-O

On Saturday and Sunday a **free kids course** is offered.

In addition, the touristic highlight of Darmstadt, the Mathildenhöhe, can be explored with a photo-O. The outstanding Art Nouveau ensemble is just a 5-minute walk from mass accommodation. Maps can be pre-ordered via O-Manager and orienteeringonline.net, but are also available at each event centre and mass accommodation for **2,- EUR fee**.

### Swimming Pool

For all participants there is a **discounted entrance** to the outdoor pool „Naturfreibad Großer Woog“, which is located directly at the event office and mass accommodation.

The competitions take place in public streets without blockages for general traffic. There are no barriers. **Following standard German traffic regulations is mandatory.** Pedestrians, visitors and tourists must be considered.
